

CORPORATE LOW-INCOME TUITION TAX CREDIT: HOW IT WORKS

- C-Corporations, S-Corporations, and Insurance Companies that pay Premium Taxes may participate in Arizona's Corporate Low-Income Tuition Tax Credit Program as regulated under (ARS 43-1183 & 43-1089.04).
- Participating corporations receive a dollar-for-dollar credit against their Arizona Corporate Tax Liability.
- Corporation contacts AZTO to donate and completes AZTO's Corporate Credit Donation Form Request. Interested businesses should contact AZTO prior to June 15th.
- Each fiscal year, the Arizona Department of Revenue (ADOR) determines the Corporate Credit Aggregate Cap. The ADOR must pre-approve each corporate donation application to monitor the annual aggregate. Visit AZTO.org to view this year's cap.
- Corporate donation must be at least \$5,000. There is no limit to the donation maximum other than it must be approved by the ADOR's annual fiscal year cap.
- ADOR begins approval each July 1st for the current fiscal year. AZTO submits donation applications for approval as directed by the state.
- ADOR has 20 days to approve or deny the corporate donation request based on the annual cap limit.
- ADOR communicates to AZTO the approval status of the donation application request. With increased interest in the program, the ADOR may create a waitlist of corporate applications before the donations are received.
- AZTO notifies the business of their approval status.
 If approved, the business then has 20 days to make the donation to AZTO. If the donation is not made within the 20 period, the ADOR approval is voided.
- Corporate donor may recommend a specific AZTO partner school but not individual students.
- Any unused corporate donation credit may be carried over up to five addition years.
- ADOR Form 335 and AZTO receipt are used in claiming the credit.
